Extract from the Trust Deed

3. THE Trustees shall stand possessed of the Trust Fund UPON TRUST as and when they shall think fit to pay or apply or cause to be paid or applied the same and the income thereof for charitable purposes in or for the benefit of the Parish and elsewhere especially in the Cotswold Hills and in particular (but without in any way limiting the generality of the foregoing)

a) For promoting the permanent conservation for the benefit of the public generally and especially for the inhabitants of the Parish of lands and buildings of beauty or historic interest and as regards lands of ecological or other scientific importance within the Parish and elsewhere especially in the Cotswold Hills and generally protecting and preserving the local rural and visual character and the amenities of the Parish and other parts of the Cotswold Hills.

b) For providing and assisting in providing colleges, schools, scholarships, exhibitions, bursaries and other grants and generally to provide facilities for education.

c) For encouraging and supporting the arts and historical research (especially in the field of local history including sites of archeological interest) PROVIDED ALWAYS that any payment made for the purpose of historical research shall be made conditional upon the results of the research being published or otherwise disseminates to the public.

PROVIDED ALWAYS

i. that the Trustees instead of applying the income of the Trust Fund may at any time and from time to time accumulate the same for any period allowed by law by investing it in manner hereinafter authorised but so that the whole or any part of any accumulations may at any time be applied in manner aforesaid as if the same had been income arising in the year in which the same shall be so applied;

ii. that the Trustees shall at all times have regard so far as it is reasonably practicable to do so to the wish of the Settlor that the character and charm of the village of Guiting Power be maintained as far as possible;
